

This amendment provides a change in the Fort Bragg, Fort Campbell, Fort Stewart and Hunter Army Air Field (HAAF), and Fort Polk RFQ that is listed below. Text additions, deletions, and changes to the RFQ are in red and a vertical line in the left margin indicates their locations. The Fort Bragg, Fort Campbell, Fort Stewart and HAAF, and Fort Polk RFQ, as amended, is provided in a Adobe Acrobat “.pdf” file on the Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District, Electronic Bid Solicitation Website <http://www.nab.usace.army.mil/> and Internet Website <http://rci.army.mil/>. This facilitates printing replacement pages to update an existing RFQ or printing a new updated RFQ.

The Army is in receipt of multiple requests from potential proposers for additional time to prepare their proposals for this solicitation. In view of these requests, and in order to maximize competition, the solicitation shall remain open an additional 14 days. The solicitation shall now close at 1630 hours (4:30PM) ET on Tuesday, November 27, 2001.

Change: Part 1, Step 1, pages 19 – 20, paragraph 4.1.1 Submission Instructions is hereby changed to read:

Administrative Minimum Experience Requirements, Statement of Qualifications, as well as completed representations and certifications required from Appendix D and paragraph 7.0 of the RFQ, must be signed and submitted in a clearly identified original hardcopy version (plus five copies), and provided electronically on compact disk (CD). Executive Order 13101 (Greening the Government through Waste Prevention, Recycling, and Federal Acquisition) must be followed for submission of hard copy proposals. Executive Order 13101 is included at Appendix E. The Administrative Minimum Experience Requirements, Statement of Qualifications and required representations must be produced in Microsoft™ Word (no exceptions), 8 1/2" x 11" format (no exceptions), using 12-point type in the Arial font (no exceptions). The Army must receive signed submissions no later than November ~~27~~²⁷, 2001 at 1630 hrs (4:30PM), ET at:
